Dear Yogis,

We are writing to share news of **Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi High School Project in Jambut**. Thank you in advance for your support. Without Shri Mataji's blessings, the collective's good will we could not have started Her school.

Sahaja Yoga in Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi Jambut School.

Our school is one of the few in the world to be named for Shri Mataji. The school is founded on Sahaja Yoga. All the parents, students, and teachers are devoted to the school. The school is fully embraced and supported by the Village who recognise it is by the blessings of Shri Mataji that the school was made possible. Our school is unique as one of the few Sahaja school in the world officially named, registered, and dedicated to Shri Mataji. Shri Mataji's photo is in every classroom and throughout the school. The children have daily Sahaja Yoga meditation. Puja is offered to Shri Mataji every day by the school assembly. Sahaja Yoga is taught once a week as part of religious instruction by Sahaja Yogis from the village. The future plans for the school when funds are available are a build a temple dedicated to Our Mother.

Every year Shri Mataji is creating new Sahaja Yogis through the children who attend our school. Many parents seeing the transformation in the lives of their children have also taken up Sahaja Yoga.

Sahaja Yoga instruction

We have two Sahaja Yogi teachers. Mr Santhos Kulal Master of Arts. Mr Shantram Pardhi our Principal teaches Sahaja Yoga and leads meditation. Every three months we have Sahaja Yoga workshops and meetings from 10am to 4pm where all the parents are invited to attend. Around 350 children and up to 150 to 250 parents attend the Sahaja Yoga seminars held :

1st seminar, 16 June 2015, 2nd Seminar 28 September 2015, 21st December 2015

How is Shri Mataji worshipped?

Our school celebrates Shri Mataji's major Puja each month, as well as meditation each morning. The children offer Aarti to Shri Mataji's photo in each classroom at the start of class each day. All the major events in the schools calendar begin with the worship of Our Mother.

Sahaja Yogi Involvement with the school.

There is foreign Sahaja Yoga involvement in support of the school. These are voluntary roles with no remuneration. Jalindar Shete and Chris Kyriacou are on the Board and assist with Sahaja Yoga advice. The building of the facilities. Financial accounting and auditing. Assistance with legal processes and guidance to the Board. Assisting students and parents. Environmental planning, securing water source. Our role is one of support.

School's Progress

We have successfully built 7 classrooms with help from foreign Sahaja Yogis, the Indian government and local Yogis from across the whole area of Jambut village.

Enrolments, Staff & Government Grant & Building:

- Enrolments currently total 344 students and range from class 1 to class 10.
- We now have 17 people working at the school

- Shri Mataji's blessings the school is legally approved, audited by Indian government each year.
- The government of India has approved a grant for school from 30/03/201 which pays teachers 40% of their base salary
- We have completed 7 classrooms and 1 office.
- We need another 3 classrooms and a mediation hall for 400 children by the end of the year. It will cost us \$10,000 to build one class room.
- We've received 7 Lakh rupees (\$14000) from the government to build the meditation hall.
- We have built a 3000 water storage for the trees and for drinking water. The children have planted around 500 trees in the school grounds.

Organising Director Body of the school & Visiting the School

There is a Board with 15 Directors which has been approved by the Education Department of Maharashtra. If you would like to be part of the school project and want to visit the school and work there, please let us know. There will be good accommodation. The school is in a beautiful valley of Maharashtra.

The children, parents and teachers experienced a recent miracle with the discovery of a plentiful supply of bore water existing within the grounds.
